

## Angiomas

Cerebral angiomas are arteriovenous malformations (AVM) causing a tangle of blood vessels and a "short circuit" between arteries and veins in the brain. They can cause cerebral hemorrhages or seizures. Angiomas are treated via interdisciplinary cooperation, i.e. by embolization and if necessary irradiation or microsurgical removal.
