However, we also have experience in treating less common disorders, e.g. Guyon's tunnel syndrome, the supinator syndrome and the tarsal tunnel syndrome – and of course all types of postoperative nerve compression (including plexus tumors). The department also offers nerve reconstruction with interposition of suralis nerve grafts.
